

Terms of Consignment

- Authors agree to pay a one-time administrative fee of \$25. This fee offsets our administrative costs.
- Authors will provide Browseabout with copies of the books (mailed or delivered to the store). Number of copies will be determined upon acceptance into the program.
- Authors receive 60% of the revenue generated from sales. Browseabout receives 40%. All payouts are CASH ONLY. No check will be issued.
- The contact for our independent author program is Jessie (books@browseaboutbooks.com). Please do not query other members of our staff about the status of your submission or, upon acceptance of your book, how many copies of your book(s) we have sold or how much you are owed. Authors should contact Jessie to arrange for a payout, or to see if any additional books are needed.
- If sales are not strong, we reserve the right to cancel the consignment contract, at which point we will contact you to pick up your books. Books that are not retrieved 30 day from the date of notice will be donated to a local charity.
- When we are able to host events safely again, Browseabout will assist authors in setting up events in the store, such as book signings or readings. These events will be advertised on our website, in our store-front windows, and on social media. It is the author's responsibility to contact local media, submit press releases to news organizations, and to market the event to the community.
- While we understand there are other outlets for you to sell your book, we ask that you refrain from mentioning them during your events with us, or in the promotion of your events with us (social media and press). For example, if you write a press release about your upcoming signing in our store, please don't say that your book is available for purchase at Amazon or Barnes & Noble. Please mention us by name as often as you can when promoting your book. If we see that you are mentioning other outlets in relation to your event with us, we have the right to cancel the event.
